**Actions of the Liquidator**

The first report to creditors was dated 14 June 2000.

I have followed up all outstanding issues and report as follows:

1. There were no voidable transactions within the two year specified period.
2. A lengthy investigation led the liquidator to the conclusion that there were no debtors outstanding to collect.
3. An investigation into the affairs of the company identified 106 individual contracts totalling \$36,326.02 that were entered into by the company for the direct benefit of its shareholder, Phillip Hackett.
4. On 30 July 2001 Mr. Hackett attended a meeting at my office whereby he agreed to commence a monthly automatic payment of \$80.00 towards the reduction of his current account balance.
5. Mr. Hackett failed to honour this agreement and has not made any contact with this office to explain his failure.
6. Mr. Hackett has moved from his last known address at 59 St Vincent Ave, Remuera. We have been unsuccessful in obtaining a new postal address for him.
7. Both Mr. Hackett's voicemail and facsimile numbers have been disconnected.
8. There were no funds recovered in this liquidation to fund any legal action against Mr. Hackett.
9. On 31 March 2003 I deemed \$36,326.02 as a dividend to Phillip John Peter HACKETT for the year ended 31 March 2001.
10. There are no matters outstanding in this liquidation.

## **Statement of Realisations and Distributions**

### **General Comments**

The liquidation of the company is now complete and the Liquidator states:
