OBSERVATIONS

The company was a holding company for shares in a subsidiary Exact Relocations Limited.

In March 2002, Garry Snedden became ill and was unable to work in the subsidiaries business. In August 2002 it became obvious that Mr Snedden was unlikely to recover sufficiently enough to resume his duties.

The decision was made to sell the assets of two related companies which meant that the services of the subsidiary were longer needed.

As a result of the subsidiary company being placed into voluntary liquidation, there was no need to retain the holding company, hence it was also placed into liquidation.

The two furniture moving companies were also placed into liquidation.
